

Enjoy warm and sunny topical weather all year round with temperatures ranging from 21°C (70°F) to 32°C (90°F), perfect for summertime getaways. Malaysia has two seasons, called Monsoon Seasons (dramatic storms) which fall between November to March and from May to September. Expect high humidity all year long with occasional rain. The annual rainfall volume varies from 2,000mm to 2,500mm.

Penang, The Pearl Of The Orient

Long glorified as the Pearl of The Orient, Penang is one of Asia's most illustrious city island blessed with charming natural wonders and cultural magnificence. It's founding in the 18th century, saw the sleepy island transform into one of the busiest trading ports in the Peninsular- connecting the best of both worlds where East meets West. The 3 Major Links in Penang



The RM6.3 billion mega project covers α 6.5km undersea tunnel from Gurney Drive to Bagam Ajam in Butterworth; 4.2km expressway bypass from Pesiaran Gurney to Persiaran Tun Dr Lim Chong Eu; α 4.6km expressway and by-pass from Tun Dr Lim Chong Eu to Bandar Baru Air Itam and a four-lane 12km road linking from Tanjung Bungah, Batu Ferringhi with Teluk Bahang.

Batu Ferringhi

One of Penang's most popular destinations, Batu Ferringhi is the Northern Coast of Penang that is synonymous with world-renowned beach resorts, untouched forest reserve, sumptuous food, international community and a host places to visit such as botanic gardens, fruit farms and art galleries. The night market brings life to the streets, while its waters are popular spots for water sports activities such as parasailing and windsurfing.

Housed in new buildings from 2006, facilities include 36 classrooms, laboratories, drama rooms, music rooms, computer labs, an indoor multi purpose hall, a 25-metre outdoor swimming pool, and a games field. The school also provides firewalled wireless internet access for students and staff who use their own mobile computers at school.
