

EVENTS

The Star Gold Coast is home to some of Australia's biggest and most sought-after events. In 2018, The Star Gold Coast was one of the major partners for the Gold Coast 2018 Commonwealth Games where it hosted a wide range of high-profile functions; it also committed to a four-year deal as the official venue and a major partner of Australian television's night of nights, the TV WEEK Logie Awards; and hosted the Country Music Channel (CMC) Music Awards, which it did again in 2019 for a second year running.

Outside of Broadbeach Island, you can enjoy a number of iconic annual events, from surfing and surf life saving events to one of the largest entertainment events, Gold Coast 600, where drivers battle it out on one of the world's toughest street tracks.

Metricon Stadium is also located nearby, playing host to a range of sporting events, festivals and concerts. This multi-purpose facility currently seats 25,000 spectators and offers world-class playing and training facilities.



EDUCATION

With Queensland's top universities within an easy commute of The Star Residences, the stars are well within reach. Bond University is Australia's first privately owned not-for-profit university, located just a 10 minute drive from Broadbeach Island.

Griffith University is ranked in the top 2 percent of universities globally and has over 50,000 students on five campuses across South East Queensland (including the Gold Coast campus – just 30 minutes by car or a 40 minute light rail). It is also renowned for its School of Medicine and National Research Centre.








THEME PARKS

EPSILON, THE STAR RESIDENCES





Residents can access The Star Grand via Levels 6 and 3, which will be home to a subtropical recreational deck for residents.

Residents will love entertaining with exclusive access to the luxurious, resort-style recreational areas on Levels 20 and 21.



Level 21 takes entertaining to new heights. Residents can impress their guests in the private bar, lounge, dining and theatre areas, all set against soaring coastal views.








THE STAR RESIDENCES

Epsilon will consist of 457 spectacular residences, available in one, two and three bedroom configurations. Residences will begin from Level 21 and continue all the way to the top of the tower on Level 63.

Each floorplan is carefully designed with floor to ceiling glazing and 2.7m ceiling heights to maximise view lines and natural light. Individual balconies will further promote the flow of natural light ensuring all residences are bright and open. All residences boast stunning views that span the coastline and hinterland, and can be appreciated from both the kitchen and living room. Ample indoor and outdoor areas provide additional glimpses for residents and their guests.





FINISHES

Residences will be fitted out with the highest quality finishes and fixtures including engineered timber floor boards to the living, dining and kitchen areas, plush carpet to the bedrooms and European appliances in the kitchen.

Purchasers will have the flexibility to customise their residences with the choice of two colour schemes – a light scheme inspired by golden tones of Gold Coast's beaches and skies to create a relaxed sense of comfort; and a dark scheme that draws from the hinterland for a sophisticated and contemporary style.

Stone benchtops contribute to the larger design vision with the architecture anchored in the smaller detailed finishes.

Island benchtop and u-shaped kitchens have been incorporated into all apartments for an integrated cooking and dining experience, complete with natural gas cooktops for optimal heat control.




